Dear Landowner,

Paramount Pipeline LLC (PPL) operates a pipeline system that crosses your property. The purpose of this letter is to inform you of upcoming activity on the right of way. PPL will be conducting a Depth-of-Cover Survey as part of the continued monitoring and maintenance of this pipeline.

The DOC Survey will collect the depth of the pipeline by probing and/or utilizing electronic devices that will then be evaluated to ensure the buried pipeline depth is appropriate for the land use, such as tillable and pasture fields. Two or three individuals will be walking the entire pipeline right of way. Digging is not required, and we do not anticipate any land damages. However, if land damage is present, please contact PPL at the phone number listed above or email JEwart@worldenergy.net.

In addition, for safety of our crew, it may be necessary for them to park their vehicles off the roadway on the right of way to avoid any vehicular traffic. PPL plans on conducting the DOC survey beginning the week of _____ and completing the survey the week of _____. However, this timetable is subject to delay depending on the weather and other unexpected outside influences. Please contact tenants or lessees who may rent the land to advise them of PPL's upcoming survey.
